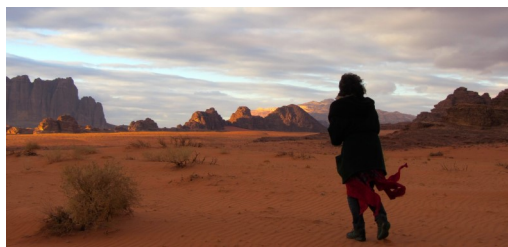
Al-Mashriq stands alone among Arabic language study abroad programs because of our unique curriculum and progressive teaching philosophy.

Most Arabic-as-a-foreign-language programs focus on Modern Standard Arabic (MSA) for all four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) and sometimes teach spoken Arabic as an afterthought. This system leaves students struggling to communicate verbally as they are not prepared to deal with the language in everyday settings.

Breaking away from convention, our integrated curriculum teaches students the **living language** as it is used every day by native speakers.

From the very first day, we train students to speak and understand **Levantine Arabic** while reading and writing in MSA. The results are remarkable, and students see notable progress in their fluency level after just a few weeks.
